

# Uinta County Library Borrower Registration Policy

## Adults:

1. The Library requires that adults have one government issued ID with a picture, and one other document that states the current mailing address. Examples include mail/bills going to the address, vehicle registration, rental lease agreements, or property tax documents.
2. The Library requests that registrants provide one local contact person who does not live in the same household as the registrant. This person will be contacted if the library is unable to contact the borrower due to moving, new phone or e-mail address, etc.
3. If the registrant does not have a local contact person, items checked out will be limited to three until information for a contact person is submitted, then regular limits will be in place.
4. Residents of Wyoming Counties other than Uinta County will be referred to their home County for registration there.

## Children:

1. Parents or guardians may register their children for library cards.
2. It is the parent/guardian's decision as to when their child is ready for a card. The library does not have any age limits.
3. The parent/guardian who is registering their child must possess a Uinta County Library Card, as the records of minors are linked to the responsible adult's account.
4. The parent/guardian is responsible for all items checked out on their child's card.
